1. Understand the different types of technique used in photography;
2. Apply creative techniques and composition rules used in photography to frame your shots aesthetically;
3. Acquire the basics of operating a DSLR camera; and
4. Produce an instructional photo-board to enhance teaching and learning materials.

Methodology

Methodologies used will include:

1. Formal presentations
2. Group discussions
3. Practical demo session and hands-on team-based project assignments
4. Project showcase and discussions

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Participants will be required to bring the following equipment to the workshop:

1. A DSLR camera or mirrorless camera
2. Zoom and/or Prime lens
3. A laptop with Microsoft Office applications
4. USB cable/SD card reader for transferring photos to laptop
