## **Master of Clinical Pharmacy**

The Master of Clinical Pharmacy prepares pharmacists to provide advanced clinical pharmacy services in hospitals and other clinical environments, and primary care settings, thereby enhancing the quality use of medicine.

### **You will develop the skills to:**

- › take a leading role in the area of drug product selection for individual patients
- › provide specialist drug information and education programs to patients and healthcare providers
- › monitor a patient's therapy
- › critically evaluate clinical research

### **You will study:**

- › clinical pharmacy practice
- › epidemiological concepts
- › pharmacotherapy
- › research methodologies
- › practical application of clinical pharmacy skills

The program is taught in Singapore by the University of South Australia on a trimester basis per year in collaboration with National Healthcare Group, Singapore. The National Healthcare Group (NHC) is a leader in public healthcare in Singapore, recognised at home and abroad for the quality of its medical expertise and facilities.

All courses have an online presence. A number of courses also incorporate onsite face to face workshops.

### **To be eligible to enter the program, students must meet the following entry requirements:**

- › hold an award from a tertiary institution which is at least equivalent to a Bachelor of Pharmacy degree;
- › be a Registered Pharmacist in their own country of residence;
- › English language; and
- › have experience in a direct patient care environment.
