# **Guide to Education Programme Management for Faculty**



#### **Description**

This programme is designed to equip newly appointed education leaders with the nuts-andbolts of managing and running an effective education programme. The programme coverage includes the management of faculty members and learners, programme financials and budgeting, and conflict resolution skills.

1 day

#### **Programme Content**

This programme comprises the following topics:

- 1. Faculty development;
- 2. Quality improvement;
- 3. Facilitation of meeting and conversation;
- 4. Managing difficult faculty and learners; and
- 5. Manpower and resource management

#### **Learning Outcomes**

At the end of the programme, participants will be able to:

- 1. Appreciate the context of Health Professions Education in NHG;
- 2. Understand NHG's framework for Faculty Management and Development;
- Gain conceptual knowledge of Quality Assurance in Health Professions Education; and
- 4. Apply tools and skills relating to managing education programmes, which includes:
  - a. Programme evaluation;
  - b. Facilitation of meetings;
  - c. Management of difficult faculty and learners; and
  - d. Management of resources, i.e. funding, manpower, etc.

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#### Methodology

This programme is designed to be an interactive learning experience for participants. Methodologies used will include:

- 1. Facilitated small group learning;
- 2. Group presentations;
- 3. Interactive exercises, e.g. discussions in small and large groups;
- 4. Case scenarios:
- 5. Problem-based learning; and
- 6. Reflective use of journals

The programme will require pre-class assignments to be accomplished, which may include:

- 1. Pre-reading materials lecture slides, journals and other articles; and
- 2. Pre-programme written assignments
