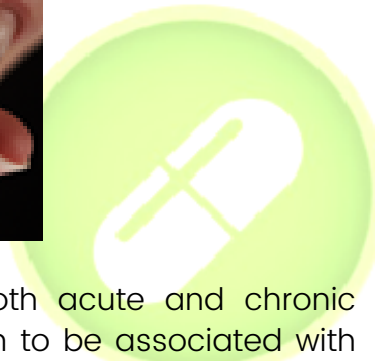

Medication Safety Certificate (Intermediate) Workshop (MSCWI) seeks to equip healthcare professionals involved in medication management and use with the knowledge and skills to improve medication safety in their workplaces.
