

Endoscopy is performed to look for any abnormalities in the stomach such as ulcers, hiatal hernia, which will affect bariatric surgery.

ENDOSCOPY

PREPARATION FOR SURGERY

- Optimise existing medical conditions
- Replace any deficient vitamins/minerals
- Build on healthy lifestyle habits
- 2 weeks very low calorie LIQUID diet





- Surgery usually takes about 2-3 hours
 - Done via keyhole surgery
- Patients stay about 2 nights in hospital

SURGERY

FOLLOW-UP WITH MULTIDISCIPLINARY TEAM

Initial follow-up is at close intervals.

This is important to achieve maximal weight loss by 12- 18 months and to ensure that adequate nutrition and lifestyle habits are kept to.
