NHG College Programmes

- ▶ More than 1900 health professions educators participated in faculty development programmes, to enhance their competencies and capabilities as clinical educators.
- ▶ 90% of programmes were redesigned and delivered online, so as to ensure learning opportunities are available for our educators.
- ▶ Launched and delivered two virtual programme runs of Learning Facilitation workshop for 57 participants to enable them to develop facilitation and engagement skills.
- ▶ Launched and delivered two virtual programme runs of Basic Psychometrics for Health Professions Education workshops for 32 educators to develop faculty in post-hoc assessment items interpretation and analysis.
- ▶ Co-organised the NHG Education Overseas Expert Programme with Yishun Health Education Office on developing Entrustable Professional Activity (EPA) curriculum with invited expert, Professor Jeroen van Merriënboer. A total of seven workshops and seven online lectures were conducted for more than 680 participants.
- ▶ Organised two Health Professions Education Webinars for more than 370 educators to share and exchange best practices, ideas and experiences to enhance digital learning in NHG.

- ▶ More than 610 healthcare professionals participated in continuing professional development programmes, to enhance their competencies and capabilities for improving patient care.
- ▶ Delivered six programme runs of the Basic Smoking Cessation Counselling Workshop for a total of 114 participants to train up healthcare professionals and HR practitioners to undertake quit-smoking initiatives.
- ▶ Delivered three runs of Workplace Mental Health Workshop (Basic) and two runs of SAFETalk Suicide Intervention workshop for more than 90 of our peer supporters, healthcare professionals and HR practitioners to equip them with basic knowledge in identifying and responding to common mental health issues at the workplace.
- ▶ Launched the NHG Mental Wellness 101 e-learning programme and made available for all NHG staff, as well as set up online learning for 100 staff from community partners in supporting workplace mental wellness for NHG and its community.
- ▶ Supported Diabetes Mellitus (DM) Education Workgroup and DM School to develop e-learning modules to train healthcare professionals in DM education. A total of seven modules had been completed and to be piloted in FY2022.

- ▶ More than 470 leaders participated in leadership development opportunities for enabling NHG transformations and organisation development.
- ▶ Delivered five virtual programme runs of the redesigned NHG Collective Leadership Conversations for more than 80 leaders, which received highly positive feedback from participants with ratings comparable to past face-to-face programme runs. In addition, conducted 2 sessions of Collective Leadership Conversations Train-the-Facilitators to prepare NHG facilitators for online delivery of the programme.
- ▶ Organised two Leadership Moments Webinars for more than 280 leaders to bring learning to them on building resilience and enhancing learning post-pandemic.
- ▶ Delivered other leadership development programmes including one run of the Dynamic Governance workshop by Prof Neo Boon Siong, two runs of Storytelling for Strategic Change workshop and two runs of Facilitating Coaching Conversations for Development workshop for a total of more than 80 leaders.
